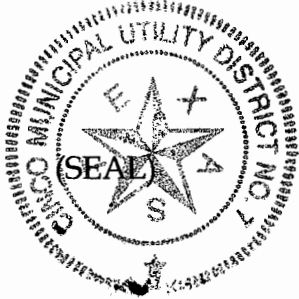



NOTICE OF MEETING
CINCO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 7

The Board of Directors of Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 7 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, April 18, 2019, at 4:00 p.m.** at the offices of Inframark Water & Infrastructure Services, 2002 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 100, Katy, Texas 77449, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Comments from the public and future agenda items.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
4. Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
6. Annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance.
7. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance;
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service; and
 - c. discuss District Rate Order, and amend, if appropriate.
8. Conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
9. Review Water Conservation Plan; approve annual report and 5-year water conservation implementation report on implementation of Water Conservation Plan; adopt Order Adopting Amended and Restated Water Conservation Plan; and authorize submittal to the North Fort Bend Water Authority.
10. Review Drought Contingency Plan and adopt Order Adopting Amended and Restated Drought Contingency Plan.
11. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachments or requests to Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 for reservation of capacity.
12. Discuss Katy Economic Development Council meetings.
13. Willow Fork Drainage District matters, including:
 - a. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
14. North Fort Bend Water Authority ("NFBWA") matters, including:
 - a. implementation of Larry's Toolbox Water Conservation Initiative.
15. Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 matters.

16. Discuss status of claim against the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
17. Discuss Emergency Services District No. 100 matters.
18. Discuss attendance at regional meetings.
