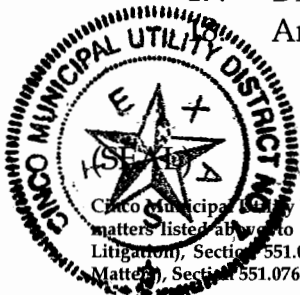



NOTICE OF MEETING

CINCO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 7

The Board of Directors of Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 7 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, May 16, 2019, at 4:00 p.m.** at the offices of Inframark Water & Infrastructure Services, 2002 West Grand Parkway North, Suite 100, Katy, Texas 77449, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
 2. Comments from the public and future agenda items.
 3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
 4. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors summer conference.
 5. Discuss renewal of District's insurance policies.
 6. Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
 7. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance;
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service; and
 - c. discuss District Rate Order, and amend, if appropriate.
 8. Review Critical Load Spreadsheet for District's facilities.
 9. Approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to deliver Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of delivery with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
 10. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachments or requests to Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 for reservation of capacity.
 11. Discuss Katy Economic Development Council meetings.
 12. Willow Fork Drainage District matters, including:
 - a. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
 13. North Fort Bend Water Authority ("NFBWA") matters, including:
 - a. implementation of Larry's Toolbox Water Conservation Initiative.
 14. Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 matters.
 15. Discuss status of claim against the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
 16. Discuss Emergency Services District No. 100 matters.
 17. Discuss attendance at regional meetings.
